- The importance of parent engagement was discussed. There is a tendency for parents to
 withdraw their involvement slightly in high school. Mr. Bomben expressed his belief that
 this is when parents should increase their involvement. As high school students gain
 more autonomy, parents should be there to advise and guide their children as they
 enter the world of adulthood
