

Who will receive a Diploma?

Those students who have:

- Earned at least 30 credits
 (including 18 compulsory credits)
 by the end of June
- Successfully fulfilled the Literacy requirement
- Completed 40 hours of Community Service (to be submitted to Student Services by (Friday, April 25, 2025)

Community Service Information:

- Only 40% of potential graduates have completed their hours
- Ensure that your community service activities are eligible.

Give your authorized hours to Ms. Wood for entry into your records by Friday, April 25, 2025.

Mho can Participate?

Who can walk across the stage?

- Students who have earned 28
 credits towards the Ontario
 Secondary School Diploma by
 the end of June 2025
- Can walk the stage but will NOT receive a Diploma

Who will receive a Certificate?

Those students who have:

- Successfully completed the Specialty programs at SJA or
- Successfully completed the requirements for the Ontario Secondary School Certificate

Private School Courses

- If you are taking a course or multiple courses at a private institution the Guidance office MUST receive an OFFICIAL final correct report card no later than Monday, June 9, 2025.
- Plan to finish your course by the <u>end of May</u> to allow time for processing of report card.
- If OFFICIAL report card is not received by this time, there is no guarantee of you receiving your diploma and/or Ontario Scholar.
- Ensure your private school uploads your course enrollment, mid-term and final mark to OUAC/OCAS.





Opt-Out Form for eLearning Graduation Requirements

Dear Parent/Guardian

The Ministry of Education, through PPM 167, has mandated that students must earn two (2) eLearning credits to graduate from secondary school, beginning with every student who entered Grade 9 in the 2020-2021* school year.

eLearning courses are Grades 9 to 12 credit courses that are delivered entirely using the internet and do not require students to be physically present with one another or with their educator, except where they may be needed for examinations and other final evaluations and other school-based supports. (PPM 167)

Parents/guardians may choose to opt their child out of the mandatory eLearning courses required for graduation.

This opt-out form is included as part of the annual course selection process for all Catholic secondary school students. This opt-out form may be distributed electronically or in print; however, a print copy of all opt-out forms must be returned to the student's school and will be included in the student's OSR (Ontario Student Record). The form does not need to be returned to the school if your child is choosing to fulfill the two-credit eLearning course graduation requirement.

To help you and your child make the best decision about the eLearning option, more information can be found on the <u>DPCDSB website</u>. Please speak to your child's guidance counsellor if you have further questions.




